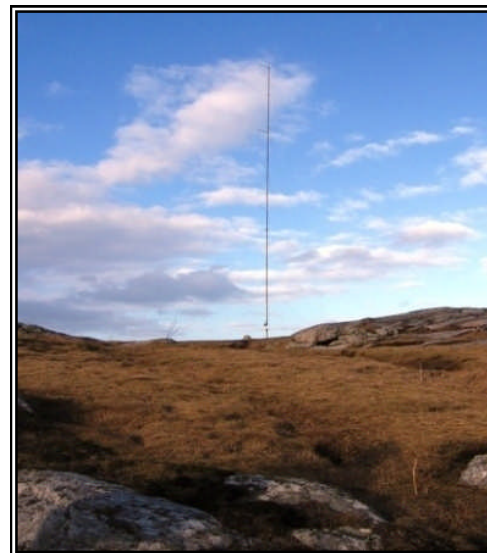

 - Development costs & capital

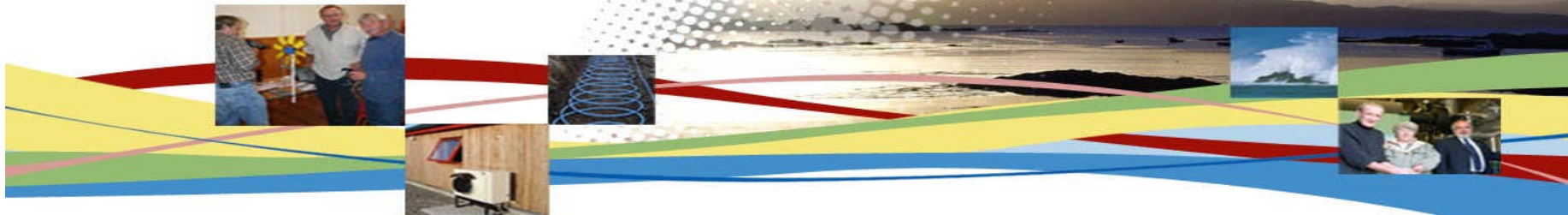


Why bother?

What can communities offer?

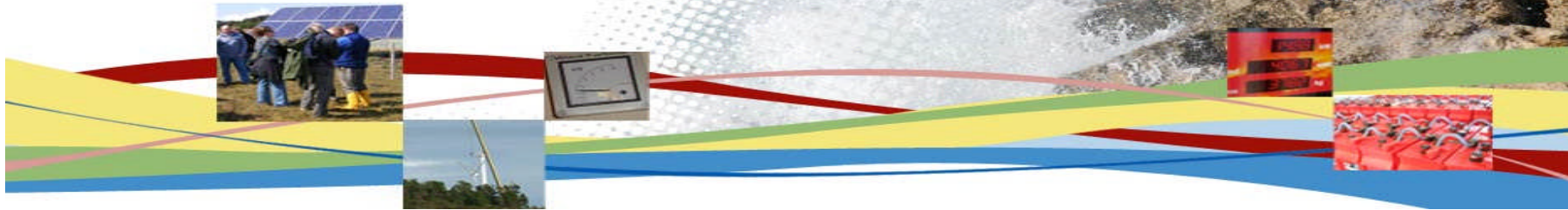
- Funding for development stages
